

About C Project files

These are written and compiled using the LPCXpresso toolchain. Each C project contains all the required source, a Quick Start and a binary that can be run without installing LPCXpresso. For a more comprehensive introduction, click the link.

C Project files are written to assist with device evaluation but will also be useful to developers developing their own application. They are written and compiled using the LPCXpresso toolchain and include all source code, including:

- Target device and host configuration libraries
- C-BUS and peripheral drivers
- Target application examples
- A pre-compiled binary for immediate device evaluation
- A Quick Start guide to get you going out-of-the-box.

C Projects target the PE0003 Universal Interface Card and the PE0601-7261 Evaluation Kit. The pre-compiled binary can be run without installing the LPCXpresso toolchain using the EC0003 GUI.
